SYNOPSIS/TARGET AUDIENCE: Proper government oversight is essential to ensure safe and effective execution of all contractor weight handling operations at Navy shore activities. *Contractor Crane Awareness* is designed to acquaint government personnel [e.g., specification writers, administrators, and inspectors of service, construction, supply, and ship repair contracts involving weight handling equipment used on Navy property] with Navy Crane Center and NAVFAC P-307 requirements for contractors and contracting officers, and provide a knowledge base on which to build upon with on-the-job experience. For NAVFAC contracts this applies to Public Works Departments, Facility Engineering and Acquisition Detachments, Resident Officers in Charge of Construction, and site specific Officers in Charge of Construction (PWD, FEAD, ROICC, and OICC). For ship repair contracts, this applies to Supervisor of Shipbuilding, Conversion, and Repair (SUPSHIP) representatives. Topics covered include NAVFAC P-307 familiarization, equipment types and terminology, responsibilities, operations, requirements, documentation, and accident identification and response.
